Changes to the Criminal Record Check renewal process:

There has been a change with the Licensing requirement for criminal record renewals. Previously we could accept a copy of your receipt to evidence you had applied for your criminal record and that was satisfactory to Licensing, this is no longer the case.

For the day home provider or any approved back up person the criminal record must not expire. If the primary provider's criminal record expires; the day home **MUST** be closed until the provider's new criminal record is back in place. When an approved back up criminal record expires they cannot care for the children unsupervised.

Criminal records take approximately 4-6 weeks to get back in the mail, so please make sure you are applying in time or you may have to pay an extra fee to get your renewal processed faster if you don't want to be closed. They still need to be renewed every 3 years.

We have an email reminder system in place to help keep everyone up to date! Your consultant will also be bringing out an expiry list for you to post on your bulletin board, so there will be a double system in place! If you have any questions please let your consultant or the office know!

- 1. Our Licensing Officer still has 2 more day homes to review. Remember to make sure that all of your documentation and health and safety are in place DAILY.
- 2. Provider T4As will be ready for pick up by the end of the month. \$15 will be deducted from your March 15th paycheck to cover the cost of your T4A.
- 3. Please email in any upcoming days off even if you don't need subbing. We need to know when Providers are closed and we need to let Licensing know which Providers are closed as well.
