Off Site Permission

Anytime a provider takes the children in her care out of her home an off site permission form must be signed. This includes but is not limited to walks, parks, field trips, school transport, library, spray parks, etc. These forms **MUST** be signed prior to any outings or field trips happening with the children. If these are

not signed prior to any outing the provider is in non compliance with our government standards.

All outings must be child oriented. If you have any concerns, comments or questions in regard to outings or off site permission forms please phone or email the office.

These are government standards. They are in place

to ensure the safety of the children and so parents are aware where their children are going during the day and what they are doing.
